The second California-Pacific Triennial, "Building as Ever," focuses on architecture and the built environment. Curated by Cassandra Coblenz at the Orange County Museum of Art, most of the works have been created for the exhibition, which highlights contemporary artists from around the Pacific Rim. Participants like Cybele Lyle (Los Angeles), Cesar Cornejo (Lima), and Yuki Kimura (Kyoto) tackle issues such as preservation, displacement, and the power structures that influence global development.
