Eighteen galleries in the Culver City Arts District are committed to supporting the effort to help the victims of the earthquake in Nepal. Some are making direct contributions and/or offering a percentage of sales and/or taking contributions to forward to the charities.

Gallerist Bruce Lurie and photographer Michael Wood have teamed up to promote the benefit, aiming to inspire collectors across LA to help Nepal by collecting art in Culver City. Wood has spent significant time in Nepal and is leveraging the timing of his show (May 30 - June 15) at the Lurie Gallery to help.
